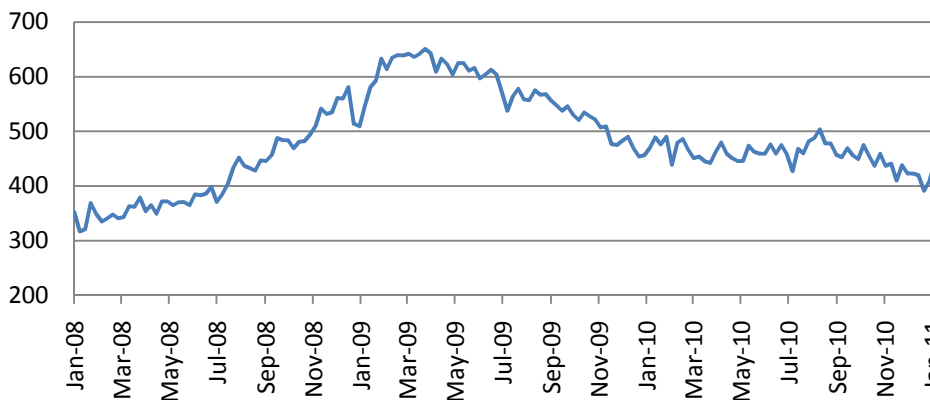


January 14, 2011

US major stock indices closed lower on Thursday with Basic Materials (-0.86%) and Healthcare (-0.50%) as the worst sectors and Telecommunications (+0.19%) as the laggards. Initial jobless claims unexpectedly rose in a week by January, 8th, to 445K, above consensus forecast of 410K.

Initial jobless claims



PPI rose by 1.2% m/m in December above consensus 0.8% while the core PPI was up 0.2%, meeting consensus estimates. Antiinflationary Trichet rhetorics, Germany's readiness to reform the European emergency mechanism and successful Portugal and Spanish Treasuries auctions supported euro. However, commodities and stocks didn't join the risk rally. Bernanke speech brought little surprise – the Fed Chairman expects GDP growth to be in a range of 3-4% in 2011.

Asian markets closed mostly red on Friday. Shanghai stock indices lost on average 0.7%. Hang Seng was up 0.23%. The Japanese Nikkei lost 0.94%. Australian S&P/ASX 200 added 0.13% while Korean Kospi was up by 0.89%.

European indices inched down at the start of the session on Friday. Dow Jones Eurostoxx 600 Index lost 0.34% at 8:30 GMT while Dax was down 0.21%. Technology (+0.56%) and Utilities (+0.52%) are the strongest sectors while Basic Materials are lagging (-0.91%). S&P 500 futures lost 0.02%.

S&P 500 Index, daily



The S&P 500 has reached 1280 (61.8% projection of wave 3 or C). After the 5th of V is finished, correction to 1230 is likely to come.

However, a pessimistic midterm target seems to be around 1000, after the pattern is completed and (C) starts.

Current support levels are at 1230, 1180, 1130, 1092, 1041, 1010, 980, 950, 870.

Resistance level: 1281.

Dow Jones Stoxx 600 Europe Index, daily



The index has broken wedge upper line as a resistance level.

Pessimistic scenario will be activated if the support at 270 is broken (this will point 258, 243, 210 levels as the final targets of the downward leg (C)).

Important support levels: 275.8, 263, 256, 243, 238, 217.

Important resistance levels – 280, 286.
